

PRINCIPAL REVIEW Policy

Approved by the School Board 15 March 2021

Rationale:

The School Board at Cambridge Middle School is committed to review the Principal's Leadership performance on an annual basis with the objective of maintaining a high quality of educational opportunities for the students at the school as well as to support the personal and professional development of the Principal and the school staff.

Principles:

- (a) The Principal's Review (LEAD) Agreement is compliant with the:
 - (i) NZ Principal Performance Agreement Guidelines;
 - (ii) Cambridge Middle School's Principal's Position Description;
 - (iii) NZ Professional Standards for Teachers and Primary and Secondary School Principals;
 - (iv) Review process Strategic Objectives; and the
 - (v) Principal's Personal and Professional Development.
- (b) The Review process is the responsibility of the Board Chair or delegate(s) and optionally, at the Board's discretion, a consultant who specialises in education.
- (c) The School Board will be provided with a report on the Principal's Review process and its outcomes annually.
- (e) The Board Chair in consultation with the School Board and the Principal, will determine the most appropriate review process for the Principal.

Policy Statement:

The School Board recognises the importance of and support for the Principal in the engagement of the most appropriate review process that is contemporary and achievable.

Key Responsibilities:

The School Board has responsibility for the implementation of this policy and will oversee a process for the development of guidelines to support the review process for its Principal.
