This year our CMS students have the opportunity to audition for our production 'Aladdin Jr' and also for our Arts Academy programme. As you can imagine this is a big undertaking. This year we have decided to audition for both of these performance opportunities at the same time.

The information regarding both AAC and Production has been emailed to you along with the scripts the students need to audition with. This gives us time to put together an audition schedule.

Audition Times:

MUSIC: most Music auditions will take place in Week 3 (during school time)

DANCE & DRAMA: will take place on Saturday 20th February.

Given the high volume of auditionees, it is important that students are on time for their audition. Please make sure you read all the information carefully for each audition. If your child is auditioning for both AAC and production, please make sure that this is indicated when you complete the online form. Students can audition in pairs, choose their own song and can choose any of the scripts. Students auditioning for both AAC and the Production only need to do one audition;. Production Dates: from 5th to 8th July in the school hall

Rehearsals: start near the end of Term 1 and run into Term 2 and are held in the school hall.

Tech Dress Rehearsal: on Saturday 3rd July and Sunday 4th July.

* It is important that all students are available for all rehearsals as this will be the only opportunity that we may get to rehearse music and dances as well as detailing scenes. Please make sure that you and your child are ready for this commitment There will be a detailed rehearsal schedule that will come out which makes clear which students will be needed and when. It is vital that if there is a specific clash that you come and talk this through with us so we may find a solution. Unfortunately, we cannot navigate around every sports practice and the hall is only available to us at specific times.
