Rationale:	Cambridge Middle School is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy working environment for our staff, students, visitors and contractors by complying with relevant health and safety legislation, standards and codes of practice.
Principles:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) The school acknowledges its responsibilities to comply with the current Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 legislation.(b) The school will take all practicable steps to protect its staff, students and others from the hazards associated with the school's activities and facilities including appropriate emergency evacuation and lockdown.(c) There is a commitment to continuous improvement, management and reporting in health and safety.
Policy Statement:	All Cambridge Middle School members, their carers, visitors and contractors will follow guidelines to comply with appropriate Health and Safety legislation as it applies to schools.
Key Responsibilities:	The Principal and the School Leadership Team have responsibility for the implementation of this policy and will oversee a process for the development of guidelines to comply with relevant Health and Safety legislation.
