

LEARNING CENTRE HEALTH GUIDELINES

Preamble:

These guidelines are in accord with Cambridge Middle School protocols as approved by the **School Leadership Team in July 2021.**

Guidelines:

- 1. The health of students and staff in the Learning Centre is of importance in maintaining a safe environment in which to interact and work together.
- 2. The aim of these guidelines is to avoid unnecessary cross-infection of common illnesses.
- 3. The school endeavours to maintain the health of staff and students alike.
- 4. The staff will be provided with and encouraged to use gloves, anti-bacterial soaps and face masks in unhygienic situations.
- 5. When a child is unwell with a common cold/flu or other infection, they must be kept at home to prevent cross-infection until that child is well.
- 6. If a child becomes unwell at school, the normal CMS procedure of home contact will be followed.
- 7. In the case of infectious diseases or a pandemic illness, such as Covid-19, all Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education guidelines and procedures will be followed.

Review: These Guidelines will be reviewed annually.
