
Attendance - We know that the bugs have been widespread and hard to shake this term. We are looking forward to everyone feeling more healthy in Term 4. A reminder that we do closely monitor attendance and that if your child's attendance falls below 80%, we will make contact with you to better understand and to offer any support if needed. 80% attendance over time means a child would miss over 1.5 terms of the 8 terms they are at CMS. Over time low attendance has a significant impact on a child's education.

Maths Trial Data - ONE News CMS Maths Trial Clip

This year, we had the opportunity to participate in a trial Maths Target Programme. A total of 112 CMS students were offered the chance to take part in this trial, making us the largest trial group in the country. These students received four extra 30-minute lessons each week over a 12-week period. Due to the positive impact of this trial, the Minister of Education has decided to roll out this intervention across New Zealand next year.

2025 Maths Trial Intervention - Year 8 - Preliminary Data



- Student voice has been very positive about how much they have been learning and gaining from participating in the intervention programme.
- Teachers have observed confidence change in class for students who are participating regularly.
- Intervention teachers also noticed a change in attitude, engagement and retention throughout the intervention.
- → The preliminary data shows that the intervention student have shown an improvement from their pre-test to their mid-test reult.


