Why Middle School?

The middle years are a significant period of learning, and of learning good habits. Research shows that this period is only surpassed by that of early childhood development. Cambridge Middle School provides a safe space for emerging adolescents to continue their journey through this important life stage. Operating a homeroom environment for this age group of students offers many benefits for students to continue to refine and develop their skills by feeling safe to take risks, supported by strong relationships with their teacher and classmates. Cambridge Middle School supports students to flourish in an environment that is emotionally and physically safe, and socially appropriate for their age group.

Transitions are an extremely important time in a child's schooling life, and Cambridge Middle School provides a type of schooling that differs from both primary and secondary schools, focusing on the unique experience of emerging adolescents. Our school has done significant work on transitions, into, through and out of our school, and research shows that an additional year can have a significant impact on a child's growth and academic achievement through developing strong relationships with key adults.

The staff working with our senior students are skilled in creating relationships with emerging adolescents and the text "Teaching Middle Years" forms the backbone to the learning - academic, social and emotional - that is offered to our students.

Our Year 9 and 10 programme offers strong academic challenges and engaging experiences:

- Social experiences that are appropriate to this age group
- A homeroom environment that is nurturing, and physically and emotionally safe
- Opportunities to explore personal interests and strengths
- Opportunities to engage in work experience
- Positive relationships between teachers and peers
- Regular and positive communication with whaanau
- Extensive range of engaging learning experiences aimed to challenge and extend learners
- A wide variety of extension and enrichment opportunities

Academic Programme

The Year 9 and 10 academic programme includes: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Sciences, Health and Physical Education, and a range of Technologies, Arts and Language opportunities.
